- 2. Whether the court erred in granting the Town, on behalf of the public, judgment on its prescriptive easement claims. Partial Judgment (October 16, 2012).
- 3. Whether the court erred in granting Lachiatto, Driver, and the TMF Defendants, as a "class" of individuals, judgment on their prescriptive easement claims. Partial Judgment (October 16, 2012).
  - 4. Whether the court erred in granting the State of Maine's claims.
- 5. Whether the court erred in denying Plaintiffs' motion to dismiss with respect to the Town's claim of custom. Order (August 17, 2010).
- 6. Whether the court erred in finding custom in favor of the Town. Partial Judgment (October 16, 2012).
